2010 seems so far in the future its never too early to start looking forward! HamJam 2010 is the big Hampshire County Camp planned for the Lake District, 14th-21st August 2010. The provisional activities at the moment (with more to be confirmed) are:



- Climbing on a real rock face and tree climbing
- Water Activities (a selection from sailing / canoeing / rafting / Dragon Boats) on Lake Windermere
- Walking in the vicinity of Lake Windermere
- High / Low Ropes Challenge
- Orienteering
- Survival Skills

This camp will only be for Scouts aged 10-14 at the time—i.e. born between 15 August 1995 and 14 August 2000.

Costs

The basic camp fee will be £185 (but we hope that this will get reduced as the event gets closer), plus £40 for food. The cost of the camp is larger than normal so the scout group is looking to setup a saving scheme from September for anyone interested so that the fee does not get paid all at once. We may also be able to do fundraising to further reduce the cost of the camp. Final payment has to be paid by the 1st January 2010.

GIFT AID

Did you know?

Because Scouts are a registered charity, we can claim gift aid on subs paid to the group. This means that for every £20 subs paid, we can claim another £4.40 from the Inland Revenue—or to put it another way, another £250 a year for the Scout Troop to spend on activities and equipment, at no extra cost to parents.

What do I have to do?

If you are a UK taxpayer paying income tax or capital gains tax at any rate you will be eligible to gift aid the subs. You must ensure that you have paid tax to at least the value we are reclaiming within the tax year, and you should fill in a gift aid declaration form to enable us to claim. If you are unsure if you have signed a declaration form, please ask Adam at the next meeting or drop us an email.
